Each class is a little different, with some meeting closer to 10 a.m., all of them would love for you to visit!

Luminous

B151

A class of young adults, made up of both **couples and singles, in their 20s and 30s**. Offering a Lenten Study on Jonah led by Mike Stroman and Scooter Smith. This growing class features regular service projects and frequent social gatherings.

Discovery

Rev. Linda Christians' Office

A small class for young adults **ages 21-34**, featuring round-table Biblical discussion and fellowship led by Steve and Ruth McCurdy. This discussion based hour explores the week's scriptures from the lectionary to discover how they speak to our daily lives. Singles and couples are all welcome.

Three Strands

B226 (second floor in Youth Building)

This class for engaged and recently married **couples in their mid-20's through 30's** strives to create a Christ-centered community for young couples where they can grow in their faith together. Join them for the church-wide Lenten Study of Jonah.

Compass

A207 (Activities Center, 2nd floor)

This growing class for committed **couples in their late 20's through 30's** explores a variety of studies, both traditional and non-traditional. The class sponsors regular service and social activities. During Lent, the class will join the church-wide study of Jonah.

Common Ground

B227 (second floor in Youth Building)

Formed in September 2010, this vibrant class consists of **parents with young children** looking for social and spiritual growth through fellowship and worship together. Social gatherings and service projects are planned monthly. Lessons consist of self-teaching (within the class) and guest teachers. During Lent, the class will join the church-wide study of Jonah.

Fellowship

R22 (Second floor above the Rotunda)

This class consists of married **couples in their 30s and 40s, all with young children**. Members strive to grow in their faith through fellowship and sharing life experiences. This class is a biblically-based study designed to promote individual growth, build relationships, and strengthen the family. The class is taught by member rotation and periodic guest speakers.

Horizons

R23 (Second floor above the Rotunda)

Primarily for **couples in their late-30's through early 50's**, Horizons features relevant Faith-in-Life topics and Bible study led by class members and guest speakers. The class engages in service projects and social events with families and couples. During Lent, the class will join the church-wide study of Jonah.

Genesis

R21 (Second floor above the Rotunda)

Faith issues relating to life experiences & Bible studies in a lecture/discussion format are taught by Steve Lufburrow. Socials and service projects emphasized. **Mostly couples aged mid 40's-60's plus.**

Sojourners

R25 (Second floor above the Rotunda)

For **single adults, ages 40-65**. Topics ranging from Bible study to faith issues in daily living are presented by Phil Murray in a lecture/interactive discussion format. Regular social and service opportunities.

Gene Decker Study

C263-264

A large, socially active class of **couples and singles, ages 45 and up**. Thought provoking lessons presented each week by class members and guest teachers on a wide range of spiritual topics. During Lent, the class will join the church-wide study of Jonah.

A large group of **persons 45 to 85 meet** in a caring atmosphere for Biblical study. Often marked by spirited discussions, the lessons are led by Hank Coleman and Jim Henderson [or vice versa]. The class is currently studying the Gospel of our church's namesake, St. Luke.

Harmony

Chapel Parlor

For persons, 50's and up, who enjoy fellowship and lively discussion and whose topics include contemporary issues and spiritual growth.

Baker-Wesley Class

These Senior Adults, 65 plus, enjoy fellowship and are inspired and challenged by the Adult Bible Study series, as led by a rotating team of facilitators.

Good Will

Rotunda

A large group, of **all ages, couples and singles**, studying Bible and Faith-in-Life topics in a lecture format, taught by Richard Ethun. Sponsors regular social and service events.

Bible Discovery

Library

All ages, couples and singles, with an exciting interactive format and featuring a mix of class discussion and lecture of in-depth Bible topics taught by Jack and Fran Steele.

Charles Wesley

Choir Room

A concentrated 30-minute class, open to **all adults**. The presentations and discussion focus on Biblical and theological topics. The class was created primarily to serve members of the chancel choir and is taught by Don Brynes. During Lent, the class will join the church-wide study of Jonah.

Open Arms

C167

This is a small, friendly class with Bible-based curriculum, excellent teachers and lively discussion. The class is open to **all ages, married or single**, and open to all ideas, service opportunities and fun. During Lent, the class will join the church-wide study of Jonah. **Open Arms will meet with the Gene Decker class in C263/4 during Lent.**

Covenant

C262

This class welcomes **all ages** to explore specific books of the Bible in a round table setting with engaging discussion on what it means for every day life. During Lent, the class will join the church-wide study of the book of Jonah.

Friendship

R11 (first floor past Rotunda)

A small, engaging class for **all ages** - discusses the Bible and Faith-in-Life topics in a round-table setting, gathering frequently for social and service events. During Lent, the class will join the church-wide study of the book of Jonah.

The Journey

R24 (Second floor above the Rotunda)

An **adult and family class, crossing generations**, offers an in-depth analysis Bible study which includes community, study, sharing, questions, life application and accountability. This class began a study of Genesis in January (walk-ins welcome throughout the study).

Joy Class (11 a.m.)

Fellowship Hall

Jesus, Others, Yourself is the focus of this class for **adults with special needs**. The class features Bible lessons, music, and prayer.
