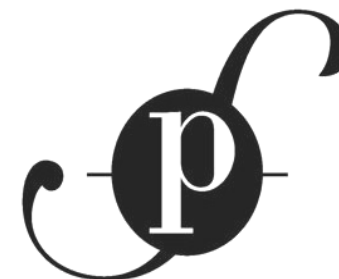

# what to do's



## Pure Sound, continued



### Sunday Mornings:

- If you are unable to be with us, contact Sid, BB, Ann or Carol
- Warm ups begin at 8 a.m. sharp! This means be in your robe and in your chair, ready to go
- If you want donut holes, come at 7:45; they are put away at 8 a.m.
- Before you sit down, check the board for the featured piece, take a bulletin & service music from the shelf by the stairs and grab a hymnal
- Use a Sunday morning clear folder for your music and bulletin
- Listen to instructions as to where to sit in the Chancel
- As you process, walk down the aisle with your partner slowly and keep the spacing constant. Sing!

- Turn and face the cross as you begin to sing the *Gloria Patria* and *Doxology*
- Be ready to sing the *Call to Prayer* and *Response* as directed
- Sing with a joyful heart and face!
- Please do not talk, make faces or sleep; you are being televised

### What to Wear:

For a uniform look, here are the Sunday morning fashion rules:

- No perfume or colognes, please
- No earrings
- Dark shoes, preferably closed toe...
- definitely NO FLIP FLOPS
- If your clothes show under your robe (i.e. pants or a long skirt), they should be dark colored (black, navy or gray)
- No hats



### Sunday Afternoons:

- Rehearsal begins at 4:00 sharp and ends at 5:30. Please be on time!
- If you unable to be with us, contact Sid, BB, Ann or Carol
- Fill out a "joys or concerns" slip if you'd like to share some news at announcement time; give it to any choir officer
- Keep your music together in a black rehearsal folder
- Raise your hand if you are missing a piece of music
- Beverages allowed only in a closed container
- Please do not talk unless we are between pieces



- Joining Pure Sound is easy; there is no audition. Simply show up a little early for rehearsal to meet with the director and be outfitted with your music and sized for a robe. Welcome to the Pure Sound family!
