Circles provide a way for women to meet regularly in smaller groups to worship, study, and be in fellowship with each other. Circles generally meet once a month. Our circles have similar tasks and goals, but are each unique in the way they fellowship and in the way they fulfill the UMW purpose.

- Afternoon Study Circle Westheimer The Afternoon Study Circle meets in member's homes at 12 noon, on the 4th Tuesday of the month (excluding summer months). Hostesses provide lunch followed by a program.
